Agriculture leads the way



The Man From Snowy River Bush Festival (MFSRBF) will once again present the Upper Murray Agricultural Field Days which was successfully run last year and well supported by local and regional businesses.

There is plenty on offer throughout the two days with a great line up of exhibitors along with many services manning the Emergency Recovery Victoria (ERV) 'Love Life' marquee.

Entertainment will be provided daily including the Kevin Sullivan family show at lunch time, woodchop (four times per day), camp oven cooking demonstration with Ranger Nick (three shows throughout Wednesday and Thursday) and silk scarf and resin serving boards workshops.

A highlight of the Field Days will be the 'Love Life' wellbeing marquee.

Hosted by local suicide prevention networking group Thrive, the special guest will be Warren Davies, 'The Unbreakable Farmer' (above).

Warren is not your average farmer. There is more to him than meets the eye. His eventful life has tested his resilience, persistence and determination and has had a massive impact on his young family, relationships and finances.

Warren has become an inspiration to many farmers across the country. He will be speaking about his own mental health journey and how he overcame adversity.


Warren's authentic, inspiring and sometimes confronting presentations are filled with take home strategies developed from his business and life journey, that his audience can implement in their day-to-day life to overcome challenges or pick themselves up and keep moving forward.

His message is simple and so very important at a time when stress is seen as normal and depression is commonplace.

The Upper Murray Field Days will be located at the former Corryong Consolidated School site on the corner of Towong Road and Donaldson Street. The cost is \$5 per person including a raffle ticket.

A shuttle bus will run between the Field Days and bush festival grounds at the Corryong Recreation Reserve for the convenience of visitors.

Attack those weeds, moss and grime

They are exhibiting at The Upper Murray Agricultural Field days with their Green Ninja SatusteamTM machine, a robust commercial grade mobile unit designed for multiple uses on rural properties. Horse owners are well aware of the importance of controlling weeds and avoiding the use of chemical herbicides that can affect the horse's digestive and immune systems. Flames, desiccant sprays and hand pulling are options but not as effective as SatusteamTM.

Managing Director, Jeremy Winer, describes SatusteamTM as "A mixture of saturated steam and boiling water delivered at low pressure and high temperature, at a volume that destroys all soft leaved and stemmed vegetation on contact".

SatusteamTM weeding is a safe process for use around horses, livestock and children.

"One of the main advantages of steam weeding is that it's a chemical-free proces," Jeremy says.

"SatusteamTM weeding eliminates the risk of exposure to harmful herbicides. It's a non-toxic process that doesn't introduce any toxins to the soil, sand or paved areas. This makes it a safe option for horse arenas and around the home where you want to eliminate possible exposure.

"Unlike chemical herbicides, steam weeding leaves no residues in the soil. All that is left on the ground is water and cooked weeds. There is no damages to surrounding plants because Satusteam weeding is a targeted process that only affects the weed it's applied to. You won't have to worry about spray drift or off target damage. It eliminates the risk of contamination of feed or water. It's even safe to use around bee hives.

"Satusteam steam weeding won't harm the soil, so you can be confident that when spot weeding in paddocks or controlling vegetation along the fence lines, in your orchard or vegie gardens, the soil health will be preserved. All you leave on the ground is desiccating weeds and some moisture.

"We observe a spike in soil organism activity after treatment that consumes the

dead weeds and incorporates them into your soil," Jeremy added.

"This is opposite of what we see with repeated chemical applications. It's a great tool in organic gardens and regenerative farming."

"The drone will then come in and clean up all those

'too close' areas under trees, around sensitive areas and closer to the tight spots, like powerlines."

The drone can also be used for smaller jobs - jobs which are out on their own, jobs that require special decontamination or are too high risk for the helicopter.

With the passion for offering the same result driven service and the customer experience always priority, Rotor Solutions knows that the new service will be of benefit to many of their current, longstanding customers and hope it opens the door for new customers who may have shied away from aerial application in the past due to a fear of drift and bad aircraft control.
